Conditions of participation

§ 1 The ERCO "Spot-on" format

- (1) The ERCO "Spot-on" format shall be implemented by ERCO GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "ERCO").
- (2) A participant shall participate in the ERCO "Spot-on" format by submitting a project, consisting of images and a brief description, via the online form at https://www.erco.com/spoton. Each participant is responsible for the accuracy of the information, in particular his or her contact details.
- (3) ERCO will award a communication package to selected projects, consisting of a professional photo shoot and an editorial report by an experienced architecture journalist, selected from all submissions of the participants at a specified time. The prerequisite for this are photo permission and access authorisation of the construction client or owner.

§ 2 Participants

- (1) Eligible to participate are planning offices and individuals who are the authors of the submitted project. The project must have been completed within the last 24 months. The lighting design should have been largely carried out using ERCO luminaires.
- (2) All personal data must correspond to the truth. Otherwise, exclusion pursuant to § 3 (2) may occur.
- (3) The participation of minors is excluded.

§ 3 Exclusion from the ERCO "Spot-on" format

- (1) ERCO reserves the right to exclude individuals and planning offices from the ERCO "Spot-on" format upon violation of these conditions of participation.
- (2) Also excluded will be anyone who provides untrue personal or project information.

§ 4 Implementation and processing

- (1) Each participant may submit one or more of various projects and thus participate several times in the ERCO "Spot-on" format. Each project must be submitted singly using the online form via the internet portal https://www.erco.com/spoton. The mandatory information in the online form must be completed in full. Participants must have read and accepted the terms and conditions.
- (2) Participation is only possible via the online form. Contributions sent in any other way are not permissible.

(3) Participants whose projects are selected by ERCO shall be notified by ERCO in writing via e-mail.

§ 5 Copyrights

The participant confirms that he or she holds all rights to the submitted images, that he or she has unrestricted exploitation rights to all parts of the images, that the images are free of third-party rights and that no personal rights are infringed in the representation of persons. If one or more persons are recognisably depicted on the images the persons concerned must agree that these images are published. The participant will ensure the above in writing upon request. Should third parties nevertheless assert claims due to infringement of their rights, the participant shall indemnify the organiser against all claims.

§ 6 Premature termination of the ERCO "Spot-on" format

ERCO reserves the right to terminate the ERCO "Spot-on" format at any time, without prior notice and without specifying reasons. ERCO will make use of this option in particular if, for technical or legal reasons, proper execution of the ERCO "Spot-on" format cannot be guaranteed.

§ 7 Granting of rights

(1) Each participant grants ERCO the non-exclusive rights of use, unrestricted in terms of space, time and content, including the right to edit the submitted images for the ERCO "Spot-on" format, to report on these (regardless of in which media, i.e. print, online and social media portals), the exercising of public relations with regard to these and for the format. Each participant of the "Spot-on" format also grants ERCO the corresponding rights to use and make available the images for its online portals and all further digital products, e.g. as teasers or downloads for third parties.

§ 8 Appeal

Legal recourse is excluded.

§ 9 Acceptance of conditions of participation
